



**City of South Pasadena
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**City Receives Grant
to Add Fast-Fill Capability to Existing
Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) Station**

The City of South Pasadena is pleased to announce that it has received a \$137,500 grant from the Mobile Source Air Pollution Review Committee (MSRC).

In 2009, the City constructed a time-fill CNG station which allows overnight refueling of the City's fleet of CNG vehicles. Currently, City CNG vehicles frequently require fast-fill capability during the day. These vehicles are refueled out of town in either Pasadena (8 miles away) or downtown Los Angeles (9 miles away). In order to improve operational efficiency, the City desires to add fast-fill capability to the existing time-fill CNG station.

The work to be performed as a part of this contract will include designing and constructing a CNG facility expansion. The work involves pouring new concrete pads for storage vessels, installing a new fueling island for the CNG fast-fill dispenser, providing new electrical power for the electronic valve panel and dispenser, and providing mechanical connections for the new storage and dispenser. It is anticipated that the construction will be completed in the month of March, 2014.

This grant is instrumental in helping the City increase the benefits of compressed natural gas to reduce air pollution and greenhouse gases.
