



# IRS Volunteer Income Tax Assistance

The VITA Program offers free tax help to people who make \$65,000 or less and need assistance in preparing their own tax returns. IRS-certified volunteers provide free basic income tax return preparation with electronic filing to qualified individuals in local communities. They can inform taxpayers about special tax credits for which they may qualify such as Earned Income Tax Credit, Child Tax Credit, and Credit for the Elderly or the Disabled. The VITA program specializes in assisting disabled taxpayers, those with low to limited income, and non-English speaking taxpayers and
