PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE
ZONING CODE AMENDMENTS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of South Pasadena Planning Commission will hold a Public Hearing on **Tuesday, July 14, 2020, at 6:30 p.m. remotely by video conference** to review and make a recommendation to the City Council for a proposed Zoning Code Amendment to amend several sections of Chapter 36 (Zoning) of South Pasadena Municipal Code to streamline planning approval processes. Applicant is City of South Pasadena Planning Department.

In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the proposed Code amendment is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines § 15061(b)(3), which states the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. It may be seen with certainty that there is no possibility this Zoning Code Amendment may have a significant effect on the environment.

This meeting is being conducted in compliance with Governor Newsom's Executive Order N-29-20 issued on March 17, 2020 to protect the health and safety of the public and to minimize the spread of the COVID-19 virus.
