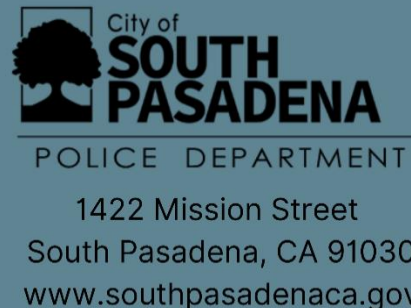

The South Pasadena Senior Center and South Pasadena Public Library will be open as places of refuge during normal operating hours. The Senior Center is open from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and the Public Library is open from 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Mayor Janet Braun added, “The City of South Pasadena is fully mobilized our Emergency Operations Center has been activated and address the current challenges and damages resulting from our extraordinary weather conditions. Our first responders and city staff are working around the clock to ensure your safety and well-being. I

encourage everyone to remain calm and united as a community as we navigate through this together. Your patience and cooperation are greatly appreciated.”
