



## Important Information about Helicopter Flight Activity in Your Neighborhood

Dear neighbor, Southern California Edison (SCE) will be in your neighborhood to upgrade its electrical facilities to provide you with a modern and reliable power grid. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause and will make every effort to minimize potential impacts during construction activities. Thank you for your patience as we complete these upgrades for you.

### Upgrades in Your Area

We will be using a blue, and grey helicopter to set new utility poles.

### What to Expect

Federal Aviation Administration regulations require we take certain precautions to ensure the safety of the public during our operation. To do this your residence must be completely vacated while the helicopter sets the new utility pole. At no time will our helicopter overfly any residence with a load attached. It will be close, but will not overfly.

### Work Timeline

- Date: 10/16/2025                      Hours: 8:00 AM – 6:00 PM

### **The total time for the evacuation is approximately 240 minutes once all residents have left.**

A Southern California Edison representative will make contact with you and/or any responsible persons at your residence with further instructions shortly before the aircraft operation is to take place. Please notify all family members, workers, or anyone who may be at your residence on this date of the evacuation. It is important to us that our activity presents as little inconvenience to you as possible.
