## **Officer Administers Narcan to Save Overdose Victim**

South Pasadena (Calif.) – On February 7, 2024, at 3:44 a.m., officers were dispatched to the 1700 block of Huntington Drive for a report of a subject who had overdosed on narcotics. Upon arrival, officers discovered the individual unresponsive.

Officers immediately administered two doses of Naloxone, commonly referred to as Narcan, into the subject's nostrils to counteract the opioid overdose. South Pasadena Fire Department Paramedics subsequently responded and transported the subject to a local hospital for medical care.

The officer's quick thinking and immediate action aided in the subject's recovery from the narcotic overdose.
