COMMUNITY SERVICES COMMISSION

The Community Services Commission, reestablished in 2022, is a seven member body that act in advisory capacity to the City Council in all matters pertaining to activities promoting the health, interests and well-being of the City's senior citizen and youth populations, and all matters pertaining to parks and public recreation; recommends policies for the control, management, and use of Community Services facilities; recommends the acquisition, use, and relinquishment of Community Services facilities; advise the City Council on development of recreation areas, facilities, programs, and improved recreation services; recommends the adoption of standards on organizations, personnel, areas and facilities, program and financial support; and takes periodic inventories of recreation services that exist or may be needed and interprets the need of the public to the City Council and Community Services Director. Qualification for serving on the commission consist of being a resident of the city.

PUBLIC WORKS INFRASTRUCTURE COMMISSION

The Public Works Infrastructure Commission (PWIC) is a nine member body to serve in an advisory capacity to the City Council on the following:

- Policy matters related to infrastructure including water, sewer, stormwater, power, transportation, streets, sidewalks, buildings, parks, and city facilities and properties;
- Transportation mobility policy matters including traffic management plans, transit, multimodal transportation and active transportation, evolving transportation and mobility technologies, parking management, and regional transportation matters;
- Federal, state, regional and local infrastructure funding and planning;
- Utility management including water, sewer, power, and stormwater;
- Providing input on infrastructure policies and plans such as the City's capital improvement program, and public works comprehensive planning documents, such as those related to water, sewer, stormwater, power, transportation, streets, sidewalks, buildings, parks, and city facilities and properties.
- The Public Works Infrastructure Commission shall also serve as a forum for community input on public works infrastructure topics.

Regular meetings are held on the 2nd Wednesday of the month every two months, at 6:30 p.m., in the Amedee O. "Dick" Richards, Jr., Council Chambers, 1424 Mission Street.
