<p>1. ROLL CALL</p>	<p>The regular meeting of the Freeway and Transportation Commission (FTC) was convened at 6:32 P.M. Commissioners present: Arce, Helgeson, Kuhn, and Sherman; Commissioner excused: Nuckols; Council Liaison absent; Mayor Schneider; and Staff present: Principal Management Analyst (PMA) Lin.</p>
<p>2. PUBLIC COMMENTS (ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA)</p>	<p>Ray Quan, San Marino resident and No 710 Action Committee member expressed concerns with a paragraph that was included in the letter of support submitted on behalf of the City regarding Assembly Bill 533 (AB 533).</p>
<p>3. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES</p>	<p>The June 19, 2018, regular meeting minutes with minor amendments (4 ayes, 0 noes, 1 absent)</p>
<p>4. COMMISSIONER COMMENTS</p>	<p>Commissioner Sherman reported that he participated in the South Pasadena Public Library’s video project by writing, narrating, and producing a history of the SR-710.</p> <p>Commissioner Helgeson stated that he would be proposing an amendment to the FTC ordinance to extend the current term limits.</p>
<p>5. COUNCIL LIAISON COMMENTS</p>	<p>None.</p>
<p>6. STAFF COMMENTS</p>	<p>PMA Lin reported that staff will be presenting a staff report to the City Council proposing the merger of the FTC and Public Works Commissions. The recommendation will include the creation of a new commission with seven members.</p>
<p>7. DISCUSSION ITEMS</p>	
<p>A. SR-710</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Early Action Projects 2. Rosemead Lawsuit 3. Focused Recirculated Draft EIR/Supplemental Draft EIS 	<p>PMA Lin reported that Staff was working on scheduling a meeting with Supervisor Barger to discuss strategies to obtain funding for the design phase of the SR-110 Hookramp project.</p> <p>Commissioner Kuhn reported that Rosemead has not appealed the May 24th judgement and that the appeal period has expired.</p> <p>PMA Lin reported that the City’s comment letter was drafted in consultation with Doug Carstens and was submitted to Caltrans.</p>

<p>4. Final EIR/EIS</p>	<p>PMA Lin reported that the most recent information indicated that the Final EIR/EIS would be made available in September/October 2018.</p> <p>The FTC discussed the language regarding the removal of the freeway stubs proposed in AB 533; the need for legislation; the reasons why the bill did not make its way through committee, and the legislative process. A motion was made to request that measures related to the SR-710 be relayed to the FTC, City Council, and PMA Lin before they are sent out; and asserts that the paragraph in the City’s letter of support for AB 533 regarding the SR-710’s traffic and air quality impacts are untrue. (4 ayes, 0 noes, 1 absent)</p> <p>The FTC discussed the release of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) that was prepared for the SR-710. PMA Lin reported that the MOA was prepared specifically for the Transportation Demand Management/Transportation System Management Alternative and was limited to the impacts that were identified in the Findings of Adverse Effect and Section 4(f). The FTC requested to receive a copy of the City’s letter after the Mayor provides his signature and the comments that were provided by the South Pasadena Preservation Foundation.</p>
<p>8. AGENDA INPUT</p>	<p>Reconfiguration of FTC term limits.</p>
<p>9. ADJOURNMENT</p>	<p>By consensus, the Commission adjourned the meeting at 7:29 P.M.</p>
