<p>1. ROLL CALL</p>	<p>The regular meeting of the Freeway and Transportation Commission (FTC) was convened at 6:35 P.M. Commissioners present: Helgeson, Kuhn, Nuckols and Sherman; Commissioner excused: Arce; Council Liaison Councilmember Joe; Mayor Schneider; and Staff present: Principal Management Analyst (PMA) Lin.</p>
<p>2. PUBLIC COMMENTS (ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA)</p>	<p>Fremont Avenue residents, expressed concerns regarding traffic and speeding on Fremont Avenue and provided the following recommendations:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. No truck signs on Columbia Street 2. Reduced speed limits, and a stop sign at Buena Vista Street 3. Installation of speed cameras 4. Inclusion of projects in the General Plan update 5. Fixing potholes 6. Improvements to facilitate pedestrians crossing the street
<p>3. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES</p>	<p>The July 17, 2018, regular meeting minutes approval was deferred to the October meeting.</p>
<p>4. COMMISSIONER COMMENTS</p>	<p>None.</p>
<p>5. COUNCIL LIAISON COMMENTS</p>	<p>Councilmember Joe announced that Lowes would be closing their stores including the South Pasadena location.</p>
<p>6. STAFF COMMENTS</p>	<p>PMA Lin reported that during the August 1, 2018 City Council meeting staff presented a recommendation to merge the FTC and Public Works Commission (PWC); Council directed staff to extend the PWC by one year, extend the term limits for outgoing commissioners by one year; and to bring back the concept of a merger in one year.</p>
<p>7. DISCUSSION ITEMS</p>	
<p>A. SR-710 1. Early Action Projects 2. Rosemead Lawsuit</p>	<p>Chair Nuckols stated that she spoke with Bahman Janka, City of Pasadena, and was informed that the City of Pasadena had requested the closure of the California off-ramp as one of their SR-710 Early Action Projects; the conversion would modify Saint John Avenue and Pasadena Avenue into two-way streets and cost approximately \$15 million.</p>

<p>3. Focused Recirculated Draft EIR/Supplemental Draft EIS</p> <p>4. Final EIR/EIS</p>	<p>Commissioner Kuhn reported that Rosemead did not submit an appeal. The FTC requested that the City obtain a copy of the formal agreement between Rosemead and Metro.</p> <p>PMA Lin reported that Caltrans has indicated that the revised Memorandum of Agreement is currently under review by the State Historic Preservation Office.</p> <p>PMA Lin reported that the most recent information indicated that the Final EIR/EIS would be made available in October 2018.</p>
<p>B. Arroyo Verdugo Joint Powers Authority – Measure M Multiyear Subregional Plan</p>	<p>PMA Lin requested that the September 18th meeting be cancelled in order to facilitate a larger public meeting which all commissioners and the general public could attend to provide public comment on the Measure M Multiyear Subregional Plan.</p>
<p>8. AGENDA INPUT</p>	<p>Fremont Traffic Calming Projects.</p>
<p>9. ADJOURNMENT</p>	<p>By consensus, the Commission adjourned the meeting at 7:50 P.M.</p>
