**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that a Special Municipal Election will be held in the City of South Pasadena, California, on Tuesday, November 5, 2019, at which there will be submitted to the voters the following Measures:

<b>South Pasadena Public Safety, City Services, and Accountability Measure.</b>  To maintain 9-1-1 emergency response times, including to home break-ins and thefts; neighborhood, school and park police patrols, fire/paramedic services, fire station operations, emergency preparedness; retain/attract local businesses; maintain streets/infrastructure; provide other general services and maintain City finances, shall the City of South Pasadena establish a 3/4¢ sales tax providing approximately \$1,500,000 annually until ended by voters, all funds remaining in South Pasadena? **NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that pursuant to Article 4, Chapter 3, Division 9 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the legislative body of the City, or any member or members thereof authorized by the body, or any individual voter or bona fide association of citizens, or any combination of voters and associations, may file a written argument, not to exceed 300 words in length, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, for or against the City measure(s).

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that, based upon the time reasonably necessary to prepare and print the arguments and sample ballots for the election, the Chief City Clerk has fixed **Friday, August 16, 2019, by 5:00 p.m.**, as posted, as the date after which no arguments for or against the City measure(s) may be submitted to the City Clerk's Office for printing and distribution to the voters as provided in Article 4 of the Elections Code of the State of California. Arguments shall be submitted to the City Clerk's Office, accompanied by the printed

name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, at the City Hall, City Clerk's Office, 1414 Mission Street, Second Floor, South Pasadena, California 91030. Arguments may be changed or withdrawn until and including the date fixed by the Chief City Clerk.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that the City Council had determined that rebuttal arguments, not to exceed 250 words in length, as submitted by the authors of the opposing direct arguments, may be filed with the City Clerk's Office, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, **not more than 10 days after the final date for filing direct arguments, or by Monday, August 26, 2019 by 5:00 p.m.**

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that any ordinance, impartial analysis, or direct argument filed under the authority of the Elections Code will be available for public examination in the City Clerk's Office for not less than 10 calendar days from the deadline for the filing of the arguments and analysis(es). Any rebuttal argument filed under the authority of the Elections Code will be available for public examination in the City Clerk's Office for not less than 10 calendar days from the deadline for filing rebuttal arguments, by Thursday, September 5, 2019, by 5:00 p.m.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that the polls for the Special Municipal Election will be open on November 5, 2019, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. pursuant to Elections Code 10242, except as provided for in Elections Code 14401.
