Historical Note

The American Legion was chartered as a nonprofit veteran's organization by Congress in 1919. The organization was established to provide service to World War I veterans, service members, and communities. Today, the American Legion consists of nearly two million members and more than 13,000 posts worldwide.

American Legion Post #140 was established in South Pasadena in 1919 and Walter I. Schoeffel was elected chairman. In 1921 voters endorsed a \$12,000 bond issue for a combined war memorial and American Legion clubhouse. In addition, Legionnaires raised \$3,000 for the building. Thus, on December 4, 1921, a crowd of twenty thousand people gathered to watch the laying of the cornerstone by Marshal Ferdinand Foch. The Post stood for approximately 70 years until its closing in the early 1990s.

Collection Description

This collection contains objects related to the membership and operations of American Legion Post #140. The most extensive element of the collection are bound scrapbooks created by members of the Post. In addition to the bound scrapbooks are attendance and membership registers, correspondence, certificates, rules and by-laws, and information on Legion Junior Baseball.

Series and Subseries

- I. Bound Books** **34 bound books**
 This series contains bound scrapbooks created by members of the American Legion Post #140. Each scrapbook is formatted as a year in review. This series also contains information for Auxiliary members and Meeting Registry books. Dated from 1919 to 1991.
- II. Attendance Registers and Directories** **12 folders**
 This series contains Post directories and meeting attendance registers. Dated from 1927 to 1984.
- III. Legion Junior Baseball** **7 folders, 3 bound books**
 The Legion Junior Baseball League was sponsored by American Legion Post #140. This series contains all-season portfolios, scorecards, and informational booklets on Legion Junior Baseball. Dated from 1964 to 1984.
- IV. Membership and Member Contact Information** **2 folders, 1 box**
 One box with small metal name plates containing the names and contact information for all South Pasadena American Legion Post #140 members and auxiliary members. Two folders containing membership rosters and delegate listings. Dated from 1954 to 1991.
- V. Correspondence** **2 folders**
 Various correspondence between American Legion Post #140 members and affiliated people and organizations. Dated 1954 to 1989.
- VI. Membership Response to Unit Dissolution** **1 folder**
 A series of surveys completed by members throughout 1989 and 1990. These surveys were given to determine what American Legion membership plans were after the dissolution of Post #140. Dated 1989 to 1990.
- VII. Reports and Statistics** **1 folder**
 This series contains various statistical reports that were recovered from American Legion Post #140 prior to dissolution. Dated 1974 to 1992.
- VIII. Rules and By-Laws** **2 folders**
 This series contains both Post and National rules and by-laws of the American Legion. Dated 1978 to 1991.
- IX. Certificates** **1 folder, 1 box**
 Various certificates, both framed and unframed, presented to American Legion Post #140 and auxiliary members for service to the community. Dated 1918 to 1991.
- X. Minutes** **1 folder**

This series contains the first meeting minutes book of American Legion Post #140 and the minutes of another early meeting in 1929. Dated 1921 to 1929.

XI. Ephemera **1 folder**

This series contains various ephemera, including sticker, brochures, posters, and ephemera from the Poppies for Veterans initiative. Dated 1864 to 1993.

XII. Member Booklets **5 folders**

This series contains both national and regional membership booklets and guides. Dated from 1946 to 1991.

XIII. Boy's State Yearbooks **1 box**

This series contains two yearbooks created by the American Legion. Dated 1972 and 1987.

XIV. Physical Objects **4 boxes**

This series contains various physical objects; including pins, stationary, dishware, a gavel, periodicals, and citations among other objects. Dated from 1916 to 1998.

XV. Photographs **2 boxes**

This series contains photographs divided into two subseries: Legion Post Commander Portraits and Printed Photographs. Dated from 1918 to 1990.
