

## **Court Guidelines**

Tennis and pickleball courts host tennis and pickleball which is a non-contact sports. Courts will open on May 15, 2020, and may be open on a trial basis, providing all social distancing and other special rules are followed in order to limit the spread of Covid-19. The following restrictions are required to ensure compliance with Covid-19 guidelines:

- Physical distancing of six (6) feet must be maintained at all times. This means before, during and after play. If this does not occur, courts will be closed
- Courts are restricted to singles play only
- Each participant must bring their own can/bucket of balls with their initials on each ball. Participants will only be permitted to handle their own equipment including balls, rackets, and paddles
- Participants will be required to wear face coverings at all times except during play
- Bring water and hand sanitizer or disinfecting wipes to wash and sanitize hands frequently
- Participants are encouraged to place their personal items (backpacks, water bottles, etc.) at a safe distance (6 feet) from other participant items to avoid any surface contact
- A maximum of one-hour play will be allowed. Participants must vacate court after playing if someone else is waiting
- No group lessons involving two (2) or more tennis or pickleball students are allowed
- Doors, entrances, and or/gates shall be open during normal operational hours
- Please be vigilant in preventing the spread of the virus by practicing good hygiene as recommended by CDC Guidelines
- Please stay home if you are experiencing any symptoms as listed by the CDC Guidelines
- Please do not enter the courts if you have symptoms or exposure risks as listed by the CDC Guidelines
- All spectators and players waiting for a court must remain outside of the fence and are encouraged to stay in their vehicles, or away from the courts, until a court becomes available. Social distancing procedures must be practiced at all times
- No handshakes, paddle bumps or physical contact between players
- City staff will conduct periodic visits to monitor that players are complying with the restrictions. Players will be asked to leave if not complying with these restrictions
- All other posted court rules apply
