NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the General Municipal Election is to be held in the City of South Pasadena, California, on November 3, 2020, at which there will be submitted to the voters the following Measure:

To maintain City services, such as Public Safety, Paramedic and Library services, shall an Ordinance be adopted to:

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to Article 4, Chapter 3, Division 9 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the legislative body of the City, or any member or members thereof authorized by the body, or any individual voter or bona fide association of citizens, or any combination of voters and associations, may file a written argument, not to exceed 300 words in length, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, for or against the City measure(s).

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that, based upon the time reasonably necessary to prepare and print the arguments and sample ballots for the election, the Chief City Clerk has fixed **Wednesday, August 19, 2020, by 6:00 p.m.**, as posted, as the date after which no arguments for or against the City measure(s) may be submitted to the City Clerk's Office for printing and distribution to the voters as provided in Article 4 of the Elections Code of the State of California. Arguments shall be submitted to the City Clerk's Office, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, at the City Hall, City Clerk's Office, 1414 Mission Street, Second Floor, South Pasadena, California 91030. Arguments may be changed or withdrawn until and including the date fixed by the Chief City Clerk.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the City Council has determined that rebuttal arguments, not to exceed 250 words in length, as submitted by the authors of the opposing direct arguments, may be filed with the City Clerk's Office, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name
